Thank you to the authors for a very well written and illuminating case report regarding the limitations of NIPT in rare cases such as with CPM. Relevant for all clinicians who are handling prenatal diagnostics to ensure that NIPT is still only used as a screening tool and that the relevant diagnostic approaches are taken in cases of a positive NIPT, or in cases of a negative NIPT but a high risk score based on blood samples and 1st trimester nuchal scan.
