## To Reviewer 1

- 1) In this study, we enrolled subjects identified by radiography only, so it is major limitation and described in discussion. Additionally, we tried to focus on pneumoperitoneum itself, so unavoidably excluded other normal condition or surgical abdomen.

## To Reviewer 2

Higher mortality in group with conservative management (supportive care with abdominocentesis) was unexpected because these conditions has been described with good progress in previous case series. In this study, we couldn't reveal clear factors affecting a high mortality in conservative group, meanwhile it is possible to suppose that a combination of some other critical situations mentioned in this study affect it.
