

Reviewer 1:

A case of Ewing's sarcoma is reported. There are some clinical data that need to be supplemented. Lung metastases occurred in the patient and CT images of the lungs before and after chemotherapy are recommended. Chemotherapy after distant metastasis is generally not considered neoadjuvant chemotherapy.

Response:

We thank the reviewer for the valuable review. Accordingly, we have added the chest CT before and after chemotherapy in Figure 3 to illustrate the outcome.

Neoadjuvant chemotherapy usually refers to the chemotherapy administered as the first step, to shrink a tumor before the initiation of main treatment, which is usually surgery. Our primary treatment was the resection of the tumor over the right femur (primary site), which we finally performed. Therefore, we referred to the preoperative chemotherapy as neoadjuvant chemotherapy.
