What about Latin America? In this region, HBV endemicity ranges from low to high with at least 7 to 12 million people infected (World J Gastroenterol. 2014 Jun 21; 20(23): 7181–719). Is there information about it? The authors mention viral factors for the development of hepatocarcinoma, among which Genoptypes B and C stand out. What about genotype F?
