1. The basis of diagnosis of HCC needs clarity

According to the Chinese guidelines for the diagnosis and treatment of primary liver cancer, the patient had the basis of chronic liver disease and cirrhosis, and the intrahepatic lesions showed typical imaging manifestations of "fast in and fast out", so the patient was clinically diagnosed as hepatocellular carcinoma, and liver biopsy was not performed for pathological diagnosis.

2. Whether Bone marrow studies were done or not? The language and grammar needs correction.

The patient's spleen lesion was enlarged unhomogeneously, and it was easier to perform puncture biopsy than retroperitoneal lymph node. Therefore, the spleen puncture biopsy was definitely diagnosed as lymphoma, and bone marrow puncture was not further performed. Nevertheless, your opinions are very accurate, and we will make positive improvements in subsequent cases. Moreover, according to your suggestions, the language and grammar of the article have been improved.
