Reviewer 1:

Line 7: add dot after patients. Line 7-12: The sentence is too long and confusing. Please try to rephrase.

Line 34: These but not “theses” Line 74: after barley dot is not necessary Line 70-71: Full stop would be better than the semicolon. Authors use too much semicolon throughout the text even when it is not required. This makes the sentences too long and difficult. Line 132, 148 and 160: byproducts instead of “by products” Line 166: Should be “an effective” Line 173: a vital instead of “an vital” Line 300: Add “-s” to the condition.

Re: All of the corrections have been made.

Reviewer 2: had no comment.

Reviewer 3: had no comment.

Reviewer 4:

1- The manuscript needs a linguistic revision.

Re: The manuscript has been edited by an English native.

2- Figure one is not good at present form and should contain references.

Re: Format of the figure 1 has been revised. Figure one has been illustrated according to author’s mind of the literatures.

3- Figure two is not helpful and thus unnecessary.

Re: Figure two has been removed.

4- Omit all references which are published as abstracts or in supplements.

Re: All of the published literatures even abstracts or supplements articles cited in the manuscript have been needed for the current comprehensive review, so we could not ignore these data and remove them.
