## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

I would like to congratulate authors for writing a mini-review regarding sub-clinical, or pre-diseased conditions in endocrinology. This is a very important topic as more and more pre-diseased conditions were categorized as a medical condition with significant implications economically. This also poses possible implication and consequence on our patients' health insurance. I concur the view of authors who stress the importance of healthy life style management and intervention rather than pharmacological, or even surgical treatment. The real aim of early detection for most of these pre-diseased conditions is for early attention to any modifiable risk factors, or appropriate surveillance for timely intervention. I would suggest the authors to address the following points to improve the quality of this mini-review. 1. Although this is a narrative unsystematic review, it is still preferably to outline briefly the method used to identify the literatures included ( eg. years, keywords, search methodology used). This can provide readers a good overview of the evidence included in this manuscript. 2. Table 3: Unit of blood sugar & HbA1C should be stated. The different definition of AHA, WHO should be referenced as in Table 2 for consistency. 3. Some typos are noted within the text. Otherwise, this is a well-written manuscript of clinical importance.
