SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

The article reported in detail a rare simultaneous bilateral floating knee case and provided a reference for the future management and treatment of this condition with clinical significance. Several issues need to be revised by the authors. 1. It is recommended that the authors search multiple databases for this disease, some of which are incomplete, such as "Bilateral Floating Knee Injury-Management of a Complex Injury" published in 2019. 2. Each figures should be labeled "A B C D" and annotated accordingly. 3. The summary section needs to be reorganized, especially in the conclusion section 4. The background section of the body of the article needs to be expanded and has typographical problems. 5. The article needs to be declared if there are ethical issues and if there is informed consent from patients.
