**Specific Comments to Authors:** 1) a rare case of metastatic translocation renal cell carcinoma, managed effectively 2) The content is well written and with apt references 3) the manuscript has some errors which need revision - the hemoglobin and serum albumin levels have decimal errors, the postoperative follow up has to detailed report about where the metastatic recurrence was which bone etc. and a mention about the chemotherapeutic agent and the dose & mode of radiation used 4) As per literature there is no advantage of preoperative alcohol ablation before cytoreductive nephrectomy, authors need to explain any particular reason it was done in this case
