I would like to praise the authors regarding their managment and good decision during managing the case. It is a rare inceiden that worth reporting specially due to its presentation which may confuse surgeons as metastasis, like what happened in the case. My only comment is that medical terms and operations need to be written correctly to match the readers common language while discussing rectal cancer. For example: instead of "radical resection of rectal cancer" in this case it is abdominoperineal resection, another example "concurrent preoperative therapy" should be neoadjuvant and then specify whether it is long course or short course.... etc.
