What is the novelty of this case report? 2)Abbreviations such as SC-CIP should be used after their spelling out. 3)The description of Fig 2.in the manuscript (lines 136-149) contradicts the actual figures. 4)There are some misspellings. Please correct them.

Dear Authors, thank you for highlighting the secondary sclerosing cholangitis after COVID-19. This patient stayed in ICU for more than 5 months with various modalities including ECMO support. The secondary sclerosing cholangitis in this patients may be due to COVID-19 or simply because of superimposed sepsis and multiple interventional due to prolonged ICU stay. The authors would need to give a full differential diagnosis and then make the diagnosis of exclusion.
