The authors describe a unique case of AMI thought to be precipitated by ice cream The diagnosis of AMI is suggested by elevated troponin levels, chest pain ingestion. and characteristic ECG changes. The authors have described the case findings in good detail including relevant findings. Literature review is good. In the introduction paragraph, please provide references with evidence regarding agitation, overwork, cold irritation, constipation and overeating causing AMI. Echocardiography revealed that the heart function was intact - do the authors mean LV systolic function was normal. Was there any mitral valve abnormality? The authors mention a murmur. blood flow returned to previous levels after 2 minutes of administration" - what was administered? "An intravenous ultrasound (IVUS) showed that the occlusion of LAD2 was normal" - please specify what this means? No plaque at the site of occlusion? "Microvascular coronary artery disease was not detected on angiography" - did they perform IMR or CFR measurement? Please specify how long prior to the presentation did the patient consume ice-cream. Could there have been any other allergic trigger?
