The manuscript has been improved according to the suggestions of reviewers:

1 Format has been updated

2 Revision has been made according to the suggestions of the reviewer

(1) Higher adenoma detection rate of endoscopist, duration of colonoscopy practice and involvement of trainee/medical resident during colonoscopy have been added as new variables in multivariate analysis. These 3 additional variables are included in table 4. As the result of these changes, the odd ratios are slightly different. However, there was no change in conclusion.

(2) Discussion about the influence of duration of colonoscopy practice of endoscopist to polyp detection rate has been added (5<sup>th</sup> paragraph in discussion section).

(2) The number of endoscopists with high adenoma detection rate and the definition of high adenoma detection rate have been added in the last paragraph of the results section.

(3) Hispanic group was mentioned as other race. In this revised version, other race has been changed to Hispanic as suggested. The change has been incorporated in table 2 and table 4.

(4) Table 1, which shows criteria for each bowel preparation quality have been added.

3 References and typesetting were corrected

4 Comments were added at the end of the manuscript, before the references.
