However, I strongly recommend that the authors consider the issue of the relationship between the gut microbiome and schizophrenia. This is very important, because currently there is a real promise in the use of pre/probiotics as auxiliary treatments in schizophrenia, aimed at improving side-effects of antipsychotics and complementing their action, particularly in terms of cognitive impairments.
