Reviewer #1

- 1. Adenoma should have thick and/or complete capsule and regular appearance of margin with benign tubules with minimal or no intervening stroma inside. In this lesion we have encapsulated but thin, irregular margin with hyperplasia-like areas of benign tubules and abundant intervening stroma. This was also specified in the manuscript.
- 2. Immunohistochemical markers were not performed as myoepithelial cells are well seen even in H/E staining and no specific marker for intercalated ducts has yet been found.

As myoepithelial cells are well seen even in H/E staining and no specific marker for intercalated ducts has yet been found, immunohistochemical markers were not performed. We believe in our case immunohistochemistry is redundant and remains as subsidiary examination in diagnosing IDL. Currently immunohistochemical markers cannot be performed.
