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SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is a meaningful case report to strengthen our awareness of the metastasis of sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma. It is worth of publishing, however some minor revision ought to be done to improve the quality of the article. 1. More cases or literature should be reviewed in the discussion part to lead to clearer recognition of metachronous metastasis of rare organs from sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma. 2. The potential molecular mechanism and related signaling pathway underlying penile metastasis from sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma must be discussed. 3. The prognosis, treatment and follow-up strategy of metachronous metastasis rare organs from sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma should be elaborated. 4. As we known, penile and sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma are closely associated with the Spleen and Kidney according to the traditional Chinese medicine theory. This paper could be more readable and meaningful if the authors could explore the etiology and pathogenesis of metachronous isolated penile metastasis from sigmoid colon adenocarcinoma with the application of traditional Chinese medicine theory.
