However, since these endoscopes have been described and showed previously in their respective publications, and since the current manuscript is already highly illustrated, we considered it opportune not to provide additional endoscope pictures.
2. Language polishing of the manuscript has been done.

**Response to Reviewer 57868:**

1. The reviewer suggests to elaborate on the combined laparoscopic / endoscopic approach via the gastric remnant after gastric bypass surgery. Although mentioned in the manuscript in brief, we believe that this aspect is beyond the scope of the current manuscript. Moreover, combined laparoscopic / endoscopic approach has been reviewed previously, as mentioned in the manuscript.
2. Labeling of pictures has been updated.
3. As mentioned in the manuscript, and as mentioned before (see reviewer 51746), postoperative anatomy and different types of endoscopes and overtubes have extensively and excellently been reviewed elsewhere. We therefore believe that additional figures will render the current manuscript too buzzy. We want to focus on specific clinical and technical situations with the current and abundant illustrations of the manuscript.
4. Language polishing of the manuscript has been done.
