The authors presented a case of peritonitis due to seminal vesicle abscess. The patient was successfully circumvented the worst scenario. The labor should be admired regarding the patient care. Results of blood examination should be presented in tables. Clinical course was not presented after the surgery. As the authors mentioned, seminal vesicle abscess is a rare condition. How would the authors speculate its cause? The patient underwent surgical treatment of benign prostatic hyperplasia. He suffered difficulty urinating, and had a long-term indwelling urinary catheter. Were there any possibilities that this past history affected the disease? Diagnosis of seminal vesicle abscess is crucial in the management of the condition. Figure 1 shows slight pelvis ascites. Where is the finding suggesting seminal vesicle abscess?
