The authors have made a respectable effort. However, there are some flaws in this manuscript. The title reflects the main subject of the manuscript. The Introduction is well resourced and the subject is presented very well. The abstract summarizes and reflects the work described in the manuscript. The abstract is compatible with the main text. The keywords reflect the focus of the manuscript. In the figures 2C nad 2D there is a mistake : NEC is positive for synaptophysin and chromogranin and not HCC The writing on the figure is not correct Please add more H&E figures with a higher magnification so as to see well the morphology of the tumor cells The references are up-to-date. Overall, this manuscript is well-balanced. It would be better to add a table in which there is a literature review of the cases of Collision Tumor of Primary Hepatocellular Carcinoma and Neuroendocrine Carcinoma reported. The style, language and grammar require minor revision
