The Introduction is well resourced and the subject is presented very well. The abstract summarizes and reflects the work described in the manuscript. The abstract is compatible with the main text. The keywords reflect the focus of the manuscript.

Reviewer #2/Point 1: In the figures 2C and 2D there is a mistake: NEC is positive for synaptophysin and chromogranin and not HCC The writing on the figure is not correct
