This is an interesting study of the influencing factors associated with ESD operation time and postoperative delayed hemorrhage, and provide the knowledge for early planning, early identification, and complications prevention. This study is well designed, and performed. The manuscript is well written. The sample size is enough, total 520 patients with early gastric cancer treated with EGC were included in this study. Inclusion and exclusion criteria are clearly described. The ESD operation process and postoperative treatment are properly listed in detail. Minor comments: 1. There are some minor language polishing, which should be corrected. 2. The equation in the results section (In = 21.674 + 8.815X1 + 3.766X2 + 10.247X3 + 4.417X4 + 3.692X5 + 2.536X6.) should be checked, "X" should be "×"? 3. The reference numbers in the text should be revised according to the journal's guideline. 4. References list should be edited and updated.

However, ESD requires advanced endoscopic equipment and skilled operation practices. The risk of complications of ESD is high, and the operation time is also long. In this study, the authors explored the influencing factors of ESD operation time and postoperative delayed hemorrhage. Overall, the topic of this study is attractive, and the results are interesting. The reviewer recommends to accept this study for publication after a minor editing.
