Dear editors and authors of the manuscript! The topic of the manuscript is extremely interesting, because there are no large randomized studies that would give an unambiguous opinion about high-risk background diseases for intrahepatic cholangiocarcinoma. However, there is no doubt that chronic autoimmune inflammation in the digestive tract is an absolute risk of developing cancer. authors have shown confirmation of this thesis by the described clinical cases. But the concept is not new. Comments: 1. is it possible to provide data on immunohistochemical examination of tumors? 2. Figures 1 and 3 are a double. 3. The discussion does not contain significant scientific results achieved by the authors, which affects the perception of the manuscript. 4. I would recommend the authors to change the design concept of their manuscript, what is the uniqueness of the cases? After all patients with ulcerative colitis and primary sclerosing cholangitis should still be under constant diagnostic and therapeutic control in view of the chronic course of the disease with periods of exacerbation. It was strange in this case to miss the formation of 10 cm in diameter.
