I read with great interest a paper entitled "HOW TO SELECT A JOURNAL FOR YOUR RESEARCH". This article is an editorial on how to select peer-reviewed journals for research. It discussed the necessity and importance of selecting a suitable peer-reviewed journal, and proposes that selecting a suitable journal needs to evaluate the value of its own research and determine the publication type. It also discussed how to select journals from multiple perspectives such as journal goals, impact factors, and publishing methods. This article is well-structured, clear in logic, and easy to read. The article has very important guiding significance for novices preparing to submit research papers and researchers entering new fields. I reviewed this article according to the standards of the review of this journal. The title ' HOW TO SELECT A JOURNAL FOR YOUR RESEARCH ' reflects the theme of the paper. The abstract of the paper briefly explains the background and theme, and further discusses the background in the introduction. The text part is concise and coherent. It should be noted that the document sets four keywords, of which the word ' bibliometry ' is inconsistent with the theme and document type of this article, and is not mentioned in the article. It is recommended to



delete and retain the remaining three keywords.
