Thank you for the opportunity to review this paper. The authors describe a very interesting case of intra-abdominal myositis ossificans possibly secondary to trauma. This is a rare case which is very well described. The etiology was determined after a thorough evaluation and the authors do a good job in describing the disease in general and the importance in its diagnosis. There are some minor issues to be addressed: 1.

Spelling- minor spelling and grammar issues should be corrected throughout the text. For example - lines 92-93, line 136 - a comma is missing, line 141 - "examinatios" and so on. 2. I found the images to be highly informative. Please see that figure 2A and 2B are the same image – not in different views.

SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

This is an interesting case report regarding a case of intra-abdominal myositis ossificans which was recurrent after surgery and followed fatal clinical course by severe complications. This report provides important clinical implications, and the manuscript is relatively well-written. I have following comments. The process of pathological diagnosis should be described in more detail, especially differential diagnosis from sarcomas (including osteosarcoma) should be described with the results of immunohistochemistry. Figure 3A and 3B are insufficient for the evidence of myositis ossificans. Figure 2A and 2B are same image. It is regrettable that an autopsy was not done in this case.
