<u>**Comment:**</u> Cholangiocarcinomas carries one of the poorest outcome after treatment, the manuscript aims to develop as assessment system to the outcomeby using ACCI score. Authors used data from different centers as retrospective evaluation of the outcome abd risk factors for CCA patient survival after curative resection. I found the manuscript is very helpful and could be the beginning to validate this score in a perspective study or by different group of clinicians. Such a score may help also in patient counseling and giving more attention to the high risk patients.

**<u>Response</u>**: Many thanks for your comment. Your recognition and encouragement is a great honor for our team. Cholangiocarcinoma, as a tumor with extremely aggressive malignancy, continues to have poor long-term survival even when patients receive

curative resection. We developed the ACCI-based prediction model to predict OS of patients after radical resection for pCCA with the hope of providing evidence-based medical evidence in the treatment of pCCA by biliary surgeons, thus facilitating them to make better treatment decisions.
