The current manuscript reviews the existing literature on the topic of hearing loss in newborns with a focus on epidemiology, etiology, classification, diagnosis, and treatment. It is a well-written manuscript with a comprehensive review of the literature. There are some concerns: - The similarity index of the manuscript is high. Please review the manuscript to paraphrase the sentences to decrease the similarity index. - I recommend using "hearing loss" instead of "deafness" in the Abstract, Keywords, and "Deafness" commonly used is for profound hearing (https://www.who.int/news-room/fact-sheets/detail/deafness-and-hearing-loss) - In the Introduction, please explain what your manuscript added to the existing knowledge. - In the section "auditory pathway": the "auditory pathway" refers to the auditory segments of the central nervous system, not the middle ear and inner ear. Please rewrite this section - It is better to use "infant" instead of "baby" - It is better to use "newborn intensive care unit" instead of "intensive care baby unit" - What does SNHL stand for? Please add it to the first presentation of the abbreviation in the text
