The manuscript is well and coherently organized. The language and grammar are accurate and appropriate. The figures and tables were sufficient, good quality and appropriately illustrative, but the legends do not cite SI units. It is important that the authors correctly identify the SI units used so that the model can be tested by other researchers.
