1. In the Introduction, the authors should describe more about what situation to use pulse therapy of corticosteroid for interstitial lung disease. 2. In the Introduction, "post-COVID-19 fibrosis usually does not progress, improve, or remain stable." The meeaning of the sentence is not clear. 3. Chief complaints: delete "complaints of". 4. Present illness: admission for glycemic control. What is the glucose or HbA1c level before the admission? 5. Past illness, the same, the authors should describe more about the uncontrolled diabetes. Do you consider that the dyspnea is related to poor control of blood sugar? 6. Personal history: treated with medicine for these conditions (DM and Afib). What medications for DM? baseline HbA1c? 7. Lab: HCO3- level? glucose level? keto body? 8. Image: What is the precise time interval between CT (2-A/B and 2-C/D)? 9. Do you evaluate the heart function? cardiac echo? BNP level? 10. In my opinion, the image and clinical course was more likely to be acute respiratory distress syndrome (ARDS). Do you apply ARDS strategy for the patient? 11. "ARDS with an AE pattern of ILD after COVID-19 infection." ARDS and ILD with AE are not an usually combined condition, with different pathophysiology. Please clarify the condition. 12. Why do the



authors only mention ARDS issue in the discussion section?
