We appreciate your comments on our manuscript.

We have made the following corrections to the points you raised.

From *Reviewer #1*

1. In writing up on tertiles of different groups, the last tertile should not be written $0.21 < \text{PVPR}$ but as $\text{PVPR} > 0.21$. Please correct everywhere in the text and figures, to make it easier for readers to follow the article. (Eg: "PVPR-T1: $0 \leq \text{PVPR} \leq 0.08$, PVPR-T2: $0.08 < \text{PVPR} \leq 0.21$, PVPR-T3: $\text{PVPR} > 0.21$ ")

→We have corrected the $\text{PVPR} > 0.21$ for the relevant section.

2. Fig 1D should be put as a separate Table.

→ We have changed Figure1D to Table 2. We corrected the numbers of Figures/Tables that have been renumbered as figure 1D changed to Table 2.

3. In Fig 3, "PVPR-T3 had a worse prognosis than the lower PVPR tertiles (log-rank test: $P < 0.05$)" should be shown on the figure with * and labelled $*p < 0.05$

→We have applied an asterisk (*) in the appropriate section ($p < 0.05$ and PVPR-T3) in Figure 3
