I congratulate the authors for this meta-analysis because is solid and with clear conclusions. However, I would desire not only the clinical impact of the different treatments, because adding a cost-effectiveness analysis could solve more questions.

Answer: None of including RCTs in our meta-analysis performed the cost-effectiveness analysis. And so we lacked of related data for costing.

(3) Reviewer **00503228**: In your keywords, have you not used "CMV or cytomegalovirus" "diabetes, or drug related diabetes mellitus"? - "There were significant effects on the CMV infection (RR..." Please say what of the two groups represented higher frequency of CMV/Diabetes for Tac and CsA
