SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

Wandering spleen with portal vein thrombosis was rare condition. As the authors mentioned that its pathogenesis was unknown, discussions regarding it would be important for such case report. I would request to describe more detailed information as follows: 1. Please show the specific data about the laboratory examinations, such as platelet, protein S, protein C, antithrombin III, prothrombin time, and activated partial thromboplastin time, even though the data within the normal limit. Discuss about pathogenesis of the petal vein thrombosis with reference articles. 2. Please show the specific data for liver function. It was also necessary to know the effect of the portal vein thrombosis. Necessity of spontaneous portal vein thrombectomy would be discussive when the data were within normal limits. 3. Please describe the condition of the thrombosis and show the image of that. The fact that the spleen was ischemic meant the torsion was acute state, resulting in fresh thrombosis. 4. Please describe the detailed procedure of the portal vein thrombectomy. 5. Please discuss about necessity of spontaneous portal vein thrombectomy. If the splenic torsion was the primary reason of the portal vein thrombosis, anticoagulant therapy might be enough after splenectomy.
