1. Please provide the references for Table 1 and Table 2. 2. Table 1 can be classified and summarized according to different age groups and different regions (such as North America and Europe, the Middle East and Asia, etc.) and attach the corresponding references in the table. 3. Please provide a diagnostic flow chart for UGIB classified according to different age groups. 4. the part "UNUSUAL CAUSES OF UGIB" is too verbose and does not require an introduction to each special disease. It can be simplified and summarized. 5. If possible, an anatomical picture of the upper gastrointestinal tract (i.e. esophagus, stomach, duodenum, etc.) and the corresponding causes can be annotated to make the article more readable and interesting for non-pediatricians or other readers. 6. Although it is a review of the cause of the disease, it is recommended to mention the clinical approach appropriately, such as giving a clinical approach flow chart or a summary of treatment according to different age groups or according to the amount of bleeding, etc., to make the article more clinically practical. 7. There are too many references in this review, I recommend deleting some unnecessary references and simplifying some paragraphs and sentences.
