Thank you for valuable suggestions and recommendation. The manuscript has been edited according to the suggestions of reviewers:

- (1) Gene names are in italics now.
- (2) Karyotype formula is expressed according to the International Nomenclature (ISCN 2013).
- (3) The breakpoint on chromosome 15 is in p11.2. The comment about 15q11.2 has been deleted.
- (4) We have added in the discussion that it is possible that heterochromatin of chromosome 1 may have a silencing effect, or otherwise interfering effect.
- (5) The claim present in the penultimate paragraph about "defining tumor translocation or aberration" has been deleted.

However, we are unable to perform additional molecular testing due to financial reasons, which is very unfortunate; it also has been the reason for the delay with our response to the reviewers. If you would consider our manuscript for publication in the current format, we shall greatly appreciate it.
