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has no conflict of interest. 2 Academic misconduct: No academic misconduct was found. 3 Scientific quality: The authors submitted a case report of congestive ischemic colitis successfully treated with anti-inflammatory therapy. The manuscript is overall qualified. (1) Advantages and disadvantages: The reviewers have given positive peer-review reports for the manuscript. Classification: Grade C; Language Quality: Grade B. The authors administered steroids and 5-ASA preparations to cases of postoperative congestive ischemic colitis where conservative treatment had been insufficient and presented cases in which these treatments were effective. Although it is unclear which is the most effective-steroids alone, 5-ASA alone, or the combination of steroids and 5-ASA-it is believed to be significant to present cases where anti-inflammatory drugs were effective as a treatment option to be considered before resorting to surgical treatment for congestive ischemic colitis. (2) Main manuscript content: The author clearly stated the purpose of the study and the research structure is complete. However, the manuscript still require a further revision according to the detailed comments listed below. (3) Table(s) and figure(s): There are 3 Figures and no Table should be improved. Detailed suggestions for each are listed in the specific comments section. (4) References: A total of 13 references are cited, including 4 published in the last 3 years. The author does not have self-cited references. The reviewer didn't request the authors to cite improper references published by him/herself. 4 Language evaluation: The English-language



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grammatical presentation needs to be improved to a certain extent. There are many errors in grammar and format, throughout the entire manuscript.
