Thank you for your comments. Based on your comments, we have made the modifications on the original manuscript and have also made some explanation as below.

**Comment:** Your paper is well constructed but you some revision of English language. Also in my opinion the Introduction section is excessively long for a case report and needs to be shortened. This can be done moving the table and description of your experience in the Discussion session. Some other literature experience will be welcome in the Discussion in order to compare your experience with other reports. Another observation is that you have to remove the phrase "). Multiple hepatic segment resections combined with abdominal wall sinus resection under general anesthesia were performed on June 20, 2020" because you repeat it few lines below. Also you have to improve the quality of the pictures and to add more explanations to them; this will increase the quality of the manuscript and will offer a better image of the case.

Secondly, I've shortened the introductory section and removed the repetitive language, revised the article to re-touch the language and re-uploaded the images.
