2. The numbers 1, 2 for references cited should be separated (line 2, under Introduction);	Corrected as advised
3. Please specify "respiratory viruses"(line 7, p.4, under Etiology);	Corrected as advised
4. Misspelling: viruuria; (line 2 from the bottom, p.6); The quality of the manuscript could attain the level of acceptance after language correction.	Corrected as advised
