(1) Reviewer# 02537782 states: "MicroRNA but not chemotherapy strategy should be the key point of the manuscript."

Authors reply: According to the constructive reviewers suggestion we have now reduced the content of the therapeutic part in this Review article by one page. Anyway, we also describe in a detailed way the current therapeutic arsenal, as we believe that for a non-oncologist who is not familiar with current treatment algorithms in colorectal cancer, this first part about the treatment options, is very helpful to understand the whole concept and the second part about predictive and therapeutic microRNAs in colorectal cancer.

(2) Reviewer# 02537782 states: The discussion part is too simple which needs reinforcement. The microRNAs that are most likely to be novel predictive biomarkers and therapeutic targets in colorectal cancer should be discussed.

Authors reply: We have now included additional 8 very recently published papers which are dealing with the predictive value of microRNAs and potential pharmacological targets for overcoming drug resistance in colorectal cancer.
