What content is expressed in Table1 and Table2 respectively, please explain in detail in the manuscript. 3. Specific treatment options for each patient should be presented. 4. It is recommended to use low, medium and high to distinguish tissue differentiation types. 5. Have these patients been tested for MSI/TMB?
