(1) We compared bowel preparation outcomes obtained with these three bowel preparation regimens, but did not assess the possible diagnostic performance of these regimens. Our study was not designed to address diagnostic performance, which will be studied at a later date

(2) Subject was assigned either to study group A, study group B or the control group on the basis of random numbers.

(3) The study protocol was approved by the institutional review board.

(4) The style of references is usual.

(5) The discussion is not too long.
