Thank you for your comments. We have added to the discussion, that the clinical decision to repeat ERCP or arrange PTC or surgery after failed precut sphincterotomy should also be based on local expertise in these techniques.

In our opinion, centers with expertise in precut sphincterotomy should perform a second ERCP because the anatomy is often clearer after 3-5 days again when the oedema has settled.


Thank you for your comments. We have added to the limitations of the study that prospective data would be desirable.
