(1) In methods section we explained the technique for OTSC deployment

(2) In results and discussion sections we mentioned the absolute numbers, relative frequencies (3/10 (33%)). For reasons of clarity, we haven't added the absolute numbers every time in the disussion section.

(3) We have added information about the simple descriptive statistics.

(4) The title of the tables have been redacted according to the content and be more explicit.


(5) The figure 1 has been changed in bars.

(6) We acknowledged the editor's comment to advise us to add the digestion key words in the title. We added 'bear claw' and 'in the gastrointestinal tract' to give the reader the right context where the OTSC clip is used. However, we did not add keywords like perforation, leckage, fistulae, because we wanted to subsume the variaty of indications under the expression 'multipurpose use of'. Furthermore with the added words the title is longer than 12 words. If the length of the title is a problem, please do not hesitate and choose the former title.
