I am sending herewith a revised copy of a manuscript that I would like to submit in response to your kind invitation to contribute an article to the World Journal of Gastroenterology / ID 02823580/.

The paper is entitled:

Upper non-variceal gastrointestinal bleeding - review the effectiveness of endoscopic hemostasis methods

List of points changed according to reviewers proposal:

- “*Helicobacter pylori* “ instead of “*Helicobacter pylori*” (seventh line, Epidemiology) – corrected.
- The reference “Table 1” was placed at the end of Epidemiology and named as Table 2 and “Table 2” was places after “early discharge” (30th line, Epidemiology) and named as Table 1 to be cited chronologically in the text.
- Table 3 was mentioned in the text – (18th line, Endoscopic management).

- Some words about the future expectations of OVESCO and the “second look” after the first endoscopy were included in MECHANICAL THERAPY and ENDOSCOPIC MANAGEMENT respectively.
- First lines of Thermal Therapy were changed to: “Thermal therapies include electrocautery probes (monopolar, bipolar (BEC) or multipolar (MEC)) and heater probe (HP), that are referred to as contact thermal modalities, and the argon plasma coagulation (APC) and laser phototherapy which are also known as noncontact techniques”.
- “is a mucosal laceration... or retching” was deleted in Efficacy and comparative analysis. “Mallory-Weis tear bleeding usually stops...” was written instead.
- Repeated “for” was deleted in second line of page 11.
- Conclusion: It would be better lesion instead of ulcer in 8th and 10th lines. I would include “availability” after “position of the lesion, “availability”, experience of the endoscopist... - **corrected**.
