This is a good review regarding the clinical management for pancreatic neuroendocrine tumors (PNETs). As a variety of therapies are available, clinical controversy remained in therapeutic strategy for PNETs. The authors reviewed the details of somatostatin analogs, small molecule kinase inhibitors, cytotoxic chemotherapy, liver directed therapy and surgical treatment. Involved two case reports help readers to realize clinical situations. I have a few minor comments. 1. The authors addressed "Table 1" in second paragraph of page 7. But I could not find "Table 1". 2. In page 18, "Question 3:" is omitted before the sentence of "When are non-surgical liver directed therapies indicated?" 3. If the schema of the therapeutic strategy for PNETs is provided, it will help readers to understand the contents of paper.
