Apr 04, 2017 · Spindle cells are usually located at the periphery compared with epithelioid cells. Perivascular epithelioid cells contain a large amount of lipids, and thus, are morphologically similar to lipocyte or lipoblast. Perivascular epithelioid cells have clear to slightly eosinophilic cytoplasm compared with smooth muscle cells.
