Questions by the reviewer:

1. Why wasn't a secondary TEVAR attempted?

The patient suffered massive hemorrhage and soon developed hemorrhagic shock. We talked about surgery treatment, but with high surgery risk. His family members declined to take a risk to perform a second surgery and discontinued further treatment.

2. "troubled liquor and Rivalta": What is the meaning of this?

Troubled liquor means exudate. And I have changed that in the manuscript.

3. "below the incisors corresponding to a fistula": Please address, this is confusing, please reword.

I have changed that to "from the incisors" in the manuscript.

4. "Finally, thoracic and abdominal aortic CT angiography showed intravenous contrast material outside the aortic stent graft, indicating hematoma ": The image does not show any contrast extravasation but rather surrounding inflammatory changes and air foci.

I have added a red arrow in Figure 3C about intravenous contrast material outside the aortic stent graft.
