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## SPECIFIC COMMENTS TO AUTHORS

In the reviewed manuscript, the authors provided a fresh minireview on pediatric transplantation during the COVID-19 pandemic, which is beneficial and timely for clinicians and pediatric transplant recipients under the current situation of the continuous mutated virus and unknown epidemic trend. The whole article is informative and scientific, with sufficient literature research and clear expression, which is in line with the purpose of World Journal of Gastrointestinal Oncology. Before to accept this manuscript, some minor issues should be corrected: 1. On page 8-9, it is suggested to add a trend diagram to express the epidemiological description of pediatric transplantation more clearly. 2. On page 11, the citing literatures skip directly to [54-57] after [48]. The missing part may be caused by the deletion of some contents, and it needs to be revised. 3. The content in Table 1 is too simple. It is suggested to add items about SARS-CoV-2+ cases of pediatric recipients or donors and complications after transplantation.
