2.Reviewer believe the author reviewed more than the references for this manuscript, but 94 references? Is it too many?

Since this is a comprehensive systematic review on an understudied topic, we had to review any potential research that could add to the depth of the manuscript. Nevertheless, we decreased some of the references and they are 78 now. Hope it is acceptable.
