The authors performed a wide and a complete review about CRC and immunity. The manuscript is well written. It has been very interesting to read the paper even if I am a clinician and I am not so confident with immunology. I suggest some minor corrections before publication: - Please always quote the references. Some statements concerning other studies have not been quoted. - "TILs" should be spelled out the first time - In the same paragraph the authors stated "The prognostic value of Tregs in CRC is still controversial... ..there is considerable evidence that Tregs are associated with a poor outcome in CRC." The two are contradictory.
