- Additional details about the PSH program were added to the manuscript, including the history of PSH, the full protocol for patients enrolled, and its current usage at UCI. A detailed protocol chart is given.
- The idea of this study is not to necessarily identify patients who need to be treated differently under a PSH protocol, but rather to suggest that PSH can normalize the perioperative experience of patients undergoing TJA. As such, we do not feel that using ASA grading to identify individuals who need to be managed differently is relevant to our study discussion.
