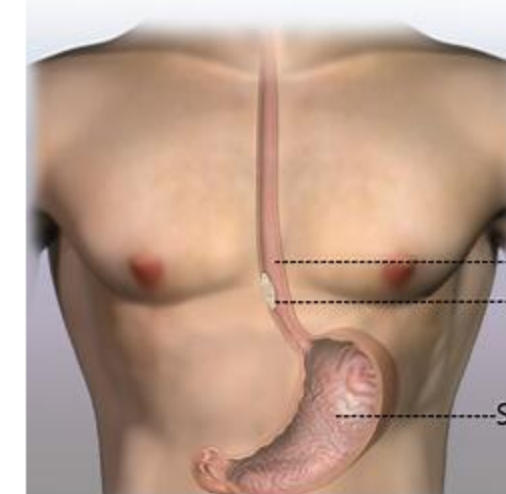

To analyse the **outcome** of **elderly** patients (≥ 70 years) with **esophageal cancer** treated with **curative** intent radio(chemo)therapy. Methods.
